## **Goodhue County Fair LawnMower Derby – 2022 Rules:**

### **SAFETY:**

- Drivers must wear long-sleeve shirts, pants and helmets.
- Must have eye protection
- LEG protection must be worn.

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- The garden or lawn mower must have factory frame. NO HOMEMADE FRAMES.
- MUST be a front end engine mower. No rear end engine mowers allowed.
- ALL mowers must have factory stock motors.
- REINFORCING THE FRAME IS NOT PERMITTED!
- Transaxles must be factory. Reinforcing or spider gears are allowed.
- Hoods must remain factory, but can be screwed down. Plastic is ok.
- Must be able to slow mower down some way - BREAKS.
- A cage can be used any size but must go from the front of the back fender to no further than the pedal step. Cage cannot go to the front bumper!
- Gas Caps must be fastened. If it comes off or leaks you will be DISQUALIFIED!
- Tires must be turf/lawn mower tires. NO dually or tractor tread.
- All plastic (besides hoods) and lights must be removed. Also the deck.
- Batteries can be used to start the mower, but must be secured down when entering the race. If it's a pull start you cannot restart the mowers, until red flag but if you are timed out before then you cant restart the mower.
- If a driver rolls over, the derby will be stopped and he or she may be disqualified if they touch the ground.
- In the event of a roll over, the derby will be stopped until the officials get the mower upright.
- Numbers must be present on both sides of the mower and helmet.
- Back bumpers cannot go past the outside of the back tires.
  - They cannot be any higher than 16" from the ground, no lower than 6" from ground, only 4" wide (tall) and can't be further than 2" past the furthest factory part on the mower (example: back fender or seat).
- Front bumper cannot go past the outside of the front tires
  - They cannot be any higher than 16" from ground, no lower than 6" from ground, must only be 4" wide (tall), and cannot be more than 2" past the furthest part on the lawn mower.
- There will be a small drivers meeting 15 min prior to the start of the derby.
- IF MOWER DOESN'T PASS INSPECTION OR PARTICIPANT REFUSES TO FIX SOMETHING THEY WILL BE NO REFUNDS!
- OFFICIALS HAVE THE FINAL SAY AND RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CHECK MOWERS AFTER THE DERBY!

## **Goodhue County Fair Kids Power Wheels Derby – 2022 Rules:**

- This is supposed to be fun for the kids, Parents, PLEASE don't ruin it for them.
- Kids ages 4-9 are welcome to participate.
- Derby is limited to 6 or 12 volt power wheels only.
- No added reinforcement for strength, let the kids have fun painting them.
- Stock tires only, no screws in tires, No Chains, Etc.
- Do not raise or lower. Power Wheels must sit like it came from the store.
- Stock battery can be replaced with a 12 volt lawn mower battery. Batteries MUST be secured.
- Helmets are mandatory, bicycle helmets are ok.
- Seatbelts are recommended.
- No Passengers.
- Pre-enter preferred and every child will receive something.
- ENTRY FEE: free
- Everyone must pay at the gate to enter the fairgrounds.
